Thanks for entering the Tamworth 10k. Our chosen charity this year is the Stan Bowley Trust.

Please come "ready to run" as changing is limited and we cannot provide shower facilities for the numbers involved. Drinks will be available at half distance.

DIRECTIONS:

Tamworth Castle, Tamworth, Staffordshire

- Tamworth Castle Pleasure Grounds: The Holloway, Lady Bank, Tamworth B79 7NA, GB from M42 Junction 10 (Tamworth Services) take the A5 North to Tamworth A51 Junction. At Ventura retail Park go straight on at the roundabout towards the town centre and Follow the event signs. From the A38 take the A5 South to Tamworth A51 Junction. At Ventura Retail Park go straight on at the first roundabout and follow event signs.
- Public Transportation: Nearest railway station Tamworth. Tamworth station is well served
 by trains from London and the north-west with London Midland. Book online at http://www.
 londonmidland.com/ and you'll pay no booking fees or postage. The station is just a 10
 minute walk from the castle.
- Parking: There are a number of car parks in Tamworth town centre. The brown Tamworth castle signs direct drivers to the Jolly Sailor car park. This is a large long stay car park with coach park facilities. It is a short 5-7 minute walk through the castle grounds to the castle. The short stay Holloway car park is a smaller car park but closer to the castle, it is located on Silver Street. Please use these car parks and do not park on the local streets.

Look out for our signs.

ON THE DAY:

What to Bring: Please wear appropriate clothing & footwear for the event.

Start Time: 10:30am prompt. Please aim to arrive no later than 10:00am please arrive in plenty of time to get yourself ready to run, and warm up. Only use the toilets and urinals provided and respect private land and property around the course, and particularly the start and finish areas.

Start / Finish Area: The Pavilion.

Route: We have a great double lap scenic course for you again this year. Map available on our website and on reverse.

Race Chips: Please note we will be using timing chips, so we can give you very accurate results. This chip is attached to the back of your race number. Please treat your race number and chip with care. Attach your race number and chip to the front of your running top at the four corners with safety pins. Your race number should not be covered by anything or put on your back, this will affect the chip, and your time may not be recorded. We DO NOT require these to be returned after the race, but if they are lost before the event and need to be replaced, then a £5.00 administration fee will apply.

Facilities: Toilets and catering facilities are available in the castle grounds, and water will be provided for all participants halfway along the route and at the Finish.


Medals & Prizes: All runners will receive a memento of the event. Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after the races. First 3 Men and First 3 women only this year.
